Please see below for further details.</p> <p>SEN Support We provide specialist ASD support to a small group of 7 children in their own specially resourced classroom. All of the pupils have EHCPs and needs that cannot be met in a mainstream class. The class is led by a teacher and supported by TAs to provide sensory and therapeutic experiences, that enable the children to learn and make good progress. We have a high adult to pupil ratio to ensure that all children receive quality first teaching and outstanding attention to their individual needs. We are seeking to appoint TAs who will work effectively as part of a team, to offer excellent care to the pupils within this setting.</p> <p>Interventions and SEN Support We have a number of children with EHCPs who can be highly successful in their learning in class with the right support. We pride ourselves on making high quality support a priority for our more vulnerable pupils and we are looking for additional TAs to facilitate this. We know that TAs who work alongside children in the classroom and deliver effective interventions, make a significant difference to outcomes, and enable our pupils with SEND to feel like valued and successful members of our school. If you feel you have the skills and experience to help some of our more vulnerable pupils and deliver effective interventions or support then we would love to hear from you.</p> <p>Support for Learning and Curriculum Delivery – EYFS up to Year 6 The curriculum is demanding for all pupils and we need adults who can work alongside children, modelling and teaching, key skills in reading, writing and maths. If you are passionate about helping children to achieve the highest academic standards so they are well prepared for their next stage in education and beyond, then we would love to hear from you. You will work under the direction of a teacher to support individuals and/or groups of pupils within a class or year group to make excellent progress in their learning.
